A warm hello to all our Bumblebee families,

We've had such a joyful, creative and busy week with your wonderful children. Their confidence, curiosity and imagination have been shining, and we're excited to share what they've been up to.

Creative Cards & Crafts

This week the children have been making cards and special crafts—some for Father's Day, and some simply for someone they love. It has been heart-warming to watch them choose colours, glue, paint and materials with such purpose.

Why this matters:

- Crafting builds **fine motor skills** as children practise sticking, squeezing, pressing and holding tools.
- It supports **emotional development**, giving them a way to express affection and appreciation.
- It boosts **confidence**, as they see their ideas turn into something meaningful.

Biscuit Decorating

The children also decorated their own biscuits using icing and sprinkles. They loved choosing colours and patterns—and of course, sharing their creations with someone special.

Benefits:

- Strengthens **hand-eye coordination** and early mark-making skills.
- Encourages **decision-making** as they choose how to decorate.
- Provides a sensory experience that supports **focus and calm engagement**.

Exploring Real Vegetables

In our role-play area and tuff tray, the children explored real vegetables using child-safe knives. They chopped, examined, smelled and investigated the textures and shapes.

Why this is valuable:

- Builds **practical life skills** and early independence.
- Encourages **scientific thinking** as they notice colours, patterns, seeds and smells.
- Supports **language development** as they describe what they see and feel.
- Strengthens **motor control** through safe cutting and handling.

Transition Visits

We've continued our transition visits to the Butterfly room. The children have been exploring their new environment, meeting the Butterfly team and growing more confident each time. We are incredibly proud of how brave, curious and adaptable they have been.

Relax Kids

Relax Kids is a wellbeing approach that helps children learn to relax, manage emotions and build resilience through movement, breathing, mindfulness, stories and positive affirmations. It supports:

- **Emotional regulation**
- **Confidence and self-esteem**
- **Calmness and focus**
- **Healthy coping strategies**

Try This at Home: Love Tokens

A simple, meaningful idea you can enjoy as a family is *Love Tokens*. These remind children that the things they need most—time, love, attention, hugs and connection—are free and always available.

You can make tokens from paper, card or even pebbles. Some ideas:

- **Hug Token**
- **Game Token**
- **Story Token**
- **Tickle Token**
- **Laughter Token**

Pop them into a jar or bag and let your child choose one when they need connection—or when you notice they're becoming dysregulated. You can take tokens too, so they see that grown-ups need love and time as well.
