AREAS:

On our messy table wooden trees and baubles have

been a big hit, helping children practice fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination as they hang the baubles onto the trees.

 Christmas card making has begun on table time. With paint, glue,

and glitter, the children explored textures and techniques—sprinkling, splashing, and even tasting the safe paint. Each child approached the activity in their own unique way, showing how differently they engage

with messy play.



Floor Time: Exploring Instruments

We introduced a variety of instruments this week. Playing with instruments supports:

- **Listening skills** tuning into different sounds.
- Coordination using hands and fingers to create rhythms.
- Self-expression experimenting with sound and music.
- **Social skills** sharing instruments and making music together.

👥 Group Time

- The adults opened three different sized boxes filled with glitter pom poms and bells, watching them drop and fall.
- They sprinkled rice onto a xylophone, listening carefully to the sounds it made.





Stage 3 brought lots of laughter as the children wore hats and sang the Hat Song. They were offered two hats, encouraging them to make their own choices.



🎄 Designing Christmas Tree

One of the highlights this week has been the children designing their own Christmas trees. They loved putting decorations on and taking them off, and this activity proved to be extremely engaging and fun for many of them.
